PRIVACY NOTICE

The **Fémagrotúr Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság** (hereinafter referred to as **"Controller"**) is the operator of the website available under the <u>https://furriertrailer.com/</u> domain name (hereinafter referred to as **"Website"**). In the present privacy notice, the Controller provides information to the data subjects regarding the data processing related to the contact form available on the Website.

In the course of its data processing activities, the Controller acts in compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as **"GDPR"**), and processes data accordingly.

II. Processing of data provided via the Contact Form

On the Website, it is possible to contact the Controller directly by using the contact form.

Data subject: the person who fills out the contact form and sends a message to the Controller through it.

Purpose of data processing: contact and communication with the data subjects, and responding to the inquiries submitted by the data subject.

Legal basis for the processing: the data subject's voluntary consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR). The data subject provides consent by submitting the data (message).

Processed data: name, company name, phone number, e-mail address, subject of the message, content of the message.

Recipient: the web hosting service provider, PERX PLUS Kft. (company registration number: 06-09-017844; registered office: Hungary, 6724 Szeged, Árvíz utca 22. Fsz. 2. ajtó; role: web hosting service provider), qualifies as a recipient and acts as the Data Processor of the Controller.

Duration of data processing: the Controller processes the data for a period of 6 months from the time of contact. If the data subject withdraws their consent or requests the deletion of their data earlier, the Controller will cease processing the data as of that date.

Possible consequences of failure to provide data: the data subject is not able to contact the Controller via the contact form. In such cases, the data subject can contact the Controller through other available contact details provided by the Controller.

Providing data through the contact form is not based on a legal or contractual obligation, and it is not a prerequisite for entering into a contract with the Controller. The use of the contact form is voluntary.

The data subject may <u>withdraw their consent at any time</u> by sending a letter to the postal address (Hungary, 5400 Mezőtúr, Szolnoki út 5. 1. ép. 6. ajtó) or e-mail address (<u>info@femagrotur.hu</u>) of the Controller. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

III. Rights of the Data Subject

The data subject may exercise their rights by sending a letter to the postal address (Hungary, 5400 Mezőtúr, Szolnoki út 5. 1. ép. 6. ajtó) or e-mail address (info@femagrotur.hu) of the Controller. The Controller will investigate the request and inform the data subject within 1 month of receipt of the request about any actions taken (e.g. deletion, rectification), the reasons for any failure to act, or the extension of the response deadline. The response deadline may be extended by up to 2 months if necessary due to the complexity of the request or the number of requests.

Right of access:

The data subject has the right to request information from the Controller regarding whether their personal data are being processed, and if so, the data subject has the right to access the personal data and information related to the processing. The right of access covers the categories of personal data being processed; the purpose of the processing; the legal basis for the processing; the duration of the processing; the source of the data; the recipients or categories of recipients of the data; the rights of the data subject; the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority; and whether the Controller applies automated decision-making or profiling, including information about the logic involved.

The Controller shall provide a copy of the personal data undergoing processing to the data subject free of charge upon the first request; thereafter, a reasonable fee based on administrative costs may be charged.

Right to rectification

The data subject may request the Controller to rectify or complete inaccurate or incomplete personal data concerning them. (For example, the data subject may request the modification of their e-mail address.)

<u>Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten')</u>

The data subject may request the erasure of their personal data processed by the Controller.

Right to restriction of processing:

The data subject may request the Controller to restrict the processing of personal data in the following cases:

- if the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject (in this case, the Controller shall restrict the processing for a period enabling the verification of the accuracy of the personal data);
- if the processing is unlawful, and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead;
- if the Controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but the data subject requires them for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims;
- if the data subject has objected to processing based on legitimate interests or for direct marketing purposes (however, in the present case, no such processing takes place).

Where processing has been restricted, such personal data shall, with the exception of storage, only be processed with the data subject's consent, or for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims, or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person, or for reasons of important public interest of the European Union or of a Member State.

Right to data portability

The data subject may request to receive the personal data concerning them, which they have provided to the Controller, in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format. The data subject may also request the Controller to transmit these data to another controller.

Right to object

The data subject is not able to exercise the right to object, given that the right to object applies to processing based on legitimate interests or for direct marketing purposes, and no such processing takes place.

Automated individual decision-making, including profiling

The data subject is not able to exercise rights related to automated decision-making and profiling, as no automated decision-making or profiling takes place in connection with the data processing related to the contact form.

IV. Available Legal Remedies

Contacting the Controller

If any violation concerning the processing of personal data arises, the Controller may be contacted by post (Hungary, 5400 Mezőtúr, Szolnoki út 5. 1. ép. 6. ajtó), e-mail (<u>info@femagrotur.hu</u>), or phone (+36-34-353-692).

Judicial remedy

The data subject shall have the right to an effective judicial remedy where he or she considers that his or her data protection rights have been infringed as a result of the processing of his or her personal data in non-compliance with data protection regulation. Proceedings against the Controller shall be brought before the courts of the European Union Member State where the Controller has an establishment. Alternatively, such proceedings may be brought before the courts of the European Union Member State where the European Union Member State where the controller has an establishment. Alternatively, such proceedings may be brought before the courts of the European Union Member State where the data subject has his or her habitual residence.

Right to lodge a complaint with a Supervisory Authority

A complaint may be lodged with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (address: Hungary, 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11; postal address: Hungary, 1363 Budapest, Pf.: 9.; phone: +36 (1) 391-1400; e-mail: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu; fax: +36 (1) 391-1410; website: www.naih.hu).

V. Access to Data and Data Security Measures

The Controller ensures that access to the data is granted only to authorized individuals. Furthermore, the Controller implements appropriate IT, technical, and organizational measures to protect the personal data it processes, including protection against unauthorized access and unauthorized alteration.
